
When Kids Fight Over Toys




HERE ARE 3 WAYS TO STOP FIGHTS OVER A TOY.

THIS MOTHER MAKES UP A GAME SO HER CHILDREN LEARN HOW TO SHARE THE TRUCK.




THIS CAN STOP FIGHTS
